Parish Council

The latest monthly meeting, a week later than usual, was well attended and began with members of the public attending to discuss cobble contractors and the car parking area in front of the Three Tuns public house. The police report was received and noted that two areas of concern were anti social behaviour and theft on two occurrences. The CCTV project was reported by Tim Swales, a member group will be formed with Osmotherley and surrounding villages who are interested in the project. The CCTV, ANPR cameras will be placed at various points around the County ward to help the police when an incident occurs to track vehicles.

The church clock face project is progressing with the administrative ramifications and progress will continue towards restoration throughout the summer.

The church wall project, which has been delayed from last year has been approved for continuing financial support from the National Park and will commence very soon.

The Sheepwash Action Group met recently and reported that maintenance would happen during June /July at the reservoir with the footpath been closed for ground work. Planning permission will be applied for a new footbridge to be erected at the north end of the reservoir to replace the stepping stones, allowing for better disabled access to the paths around the reservoir. The group are extremely grateful to all the volunteers who help at Sheepwash.

The A19 northbound carriageway between the junctions of Knayton to Nether Silton and Over Silton to Osmotherley will have carriageway works which will be carried out under a series of night-time closures between 8pm and 6am. The works are due to start on Monday 27th June until 7th July. Diversions through Northallerton will take place as last year.

Hambleton District Council asked the council for support in helping residents that wish to, to replace recycling bins with clear sacks. Distribution of these sacks is a concern and we are looking at ways that this can be achieved effectively. Residents interested in clear sacks as an alternative to blue bins should contact the clerk initially. It was also reported by the HDC Ward member that, following a visit to the recycling centre that HDC residents should be congratulated in the quality of recycling that it has done to date.

The Village Hall Committee requested financial support towards the upcoming Angel Festival in November. This was agreed enthusiastically.

Six planning applications were put before the PC for approval and all were supported.

A water leak was noted in the highway outside 23 North End and it was agreed that this be reported to NYCC asap and deterioration of the road surface on Back Lane near the junction with South End, was noted.

Finally the issue of residents cutting grass outside their properties was raised and it was agreed that, should individual residents wish to cut the grass bordering their property, it should be encouraged.
