Parish Council

The council, with full attendance, met at the village hall at 7.30pm as usual. The Chairman has secured a grant from NYCC to install a series of CCTV cameras in areas which will help secure and identify perpetrators of crime in the parish council area. This is grant supported in entirety and with the full support of the police.

A number of highways issues were discussed including reporting potholes at Chester Lane, Sowerby under Cotcliffe and at School Lane, Osmotherley. Also the cattlegrid at Snilesworth is becoming dangerous. The church wall repairs, which have stalled over the winter, were discussed and a new contractor will begin work very soon. The steps to the Catholic Church, which had been reported as unstable, will be repaired with new paving slabs shortly. Two planning applications have been received for properties in Clack Lane and issues will be reported back to NY Moors. Finally it was noted in last month's edition that the clerks email address was incorrect. The correct address is clerk.osmotherleyareapc@gmail.com

New recycling arrangements - Hambleton District Council

Recycling bins have been distributed by HDC and it was stressed that these bins could cause problems for residents with limited space and thus impact on the village. Residents are urged to contact HDC if they have storage issues since replacement bags will be available.

The recycling banks at the school and Tim Swales garage will be removed soon by the Council. This is because the council is withdrawing all mini recycling banks following the issuing of extra wheelie bins or bags for individual household waste.
