If you would like to share a longer prayer there is a small box, for this purpose, next to the tree.

The prison focuses on helping longer term prisoners re-settle in The North of England and Yorkshire. This it does by actively encouraging them to participate in community pay back projects in the Teesside area before progressing to paid employment in the community and/or attendance at a local college or university.
