Osmotherley Area Parish Council

November 2019 Meeting. Due to a clash of events at the Village Hall the meeting was moved to Kirby Sigston Village Hall.

The meeting considered 3 planning applications, which were supported and considered monthly reports from the Police (where 5 incidents were reported) and the financial report.

However much of the meeting was given over to the issues raised by residents over the alterations to the front of the Queen Catherine. It is important to note that the Parish Council (PC) does not own the parking area or the paved area in front of the Queen Catherine, however it does have control over it.

The lack of consideration to consult with the PC by the owner has resulted in much consternation within the village. The North York Moors Planning authority are satisfied that the current work does not require planning permission and therefore the necessity to consult with the PC has been negated! The work commenced suddenly with no forewarning. The owner had previously indicated that the work would not commence until February 2020, giving ample time for consultation. The number of parking spaces, it appears, has been reduced and with the kerb inclusion, any attempt to reinstate these has been taken away. Again, we were unaware of the detail of the plans and no consideration was given to consult in an appropriate manner.

A concerned resident attended the meeting to put forward views regarding the approvals necessary under planning rules and regulations and the many communications were reported at the meeting from concerned residents. Many of the issues which have been on-going since the first set of 'improvements' to the property have been handled by the PC in consultation with the owner. The North Yorkshire Moors Planning authority commenced enforcement action against the owner and are now satisfied that most of the issues have been resolved successfully. However the latest set of alterations to the car parking spaces, without due consideration to the views of the village, as represented by the members of the Parish Council, has prompted this response. It is hoped that any further works to the building in the future will be via planning application and therefore full consultation will occur. Indeed the owner has recently submitted a planning application for a French drain and 13 replacement windows, which was supported by the PC.

The children are provided with soya porridge for breakfast and they receive lunch. When first admitted, most children were underweight for their age and some could not concentrate because of lack of nourishment at home. Your donations will help the Centre to continue to provide much needed support for these children.

Catherine is a key supporter of our community group - being a regular contributor to our soup lunches. We hope you will be able to join us to support Catherine and this deserving charity.

In addition, Catherine and Vanessa will provide a Traidcraft stall selling fair trade crafts and gifts from around the world. Everyone is welcome.
