## Osmotherley Area Parish Council-May

Following the recent election the new council met, welcoming 3 new members to its ranks (Paul Howlett and Barrie Robinson for Osmotherley and Mary Kay for Kirby Sigston). The AGM was held to elect a Chairperson. Richard Horner was proposed and accepted the role for another year. Carolyn Nozedar was proposed and accepted the role of Vice Chairperson.

Ongoing issues were considered, including a hole in the road and verge on North End, the road markings finally being completed on West End and the 'No Parking' signs erected to help with traffic flow on North end. Further concerns over a culvert causing leakage onto Clack Bank was discussed again and would be taken up with the landowners.

Grants have been made to assist the villages of Osmotherley and Kirby Sigston in their activities to enjoy the Queen's Jubilee celebrations and it is hoped that these go well following all the hard work by volunteers in the community.

The concerns expressed to the North York Moors NP regarding the Three Tuns have been looked into and some acted upon.

Some comments have been received regarding the appearance of the village after the grasscutting and these would be taken up with the contractor.

A letter, sent to NYMNP and copied to us was read out regarding concerns over controlling the numbers of second homes and holiday lets. The need for affordable homes and the knock-on effect it has on the viability of the school were also discussed and will be fed back to the NYMNP as areas of concern.

The meeting was updated on the newly approved management plan for the park. It was requested that any new proposed cycle routes were to be multi-use.

Three planning applications were considered and approved, and the external audit return of the annual accounts approved for submission.

Concerns were expressed by the representatives of Thimbleby and Ellerbeck at the number of speeding vehicles on the roads in their areas and they have asked whether a traffic survey could be undertaken to assess the problem.

The next meeting of the council is on the 16th June 2022.
