Osmotherley Area Parish Council-April

The council met on 21st April 2022 to discuss issues following our previous meeting and others that were raised at the meeting.

Updates were provided on the footbridge replacement - due now in June due to further supply issues; lining and gully emptying still not scheduled; the obstruction in front of the QC has been removed and welcomed by all; 2 No Parking signs have been erected by the council on North End to emphasise the passing place and a third approved at the meeting; alterations to the appearance of the Three Tuns were noted.

No major police issues occurred during the period and 4 planning applications were supported.

A hole has appeared in the verge and highway on North End and reported to Highways for action.

The council agreed to provide a small financial contribution to support the community group arranging festivities for the Queens Jubilee weekend.

The Clerk presented the year end accounts and bank reconciliation for consideration. These were duly approved.

We were asked to consider purchasing a flag to show support for Ukraine and it was agreed to pursue this further.

Finally three long serving councillors have resigned. Noel Coward, Martyn Stafford and Robin Harker were attending their last meeting before the election on May 5th and the chairman expressed gratitude to these 'volunteers' for their wealth of experience, which would be very difficult to replace.

Toad Patrol

Every Spring hundreds of toads make the journey from themoor down to Cod Beck to mate and spawn before returning to the moor. Their preferred conditions are just after dusk when it is over 10 degrees Celsius. They are joined by frogs and newts, the latter like the roads to be damp. It is a challenging journey at the best of times, but is made even more so by the fact that the road from Swainby to Osmotherley is very popular at this time on an evening.

For this reason, for a few weeks in March/April, patrols take place to collect toads from the road and deposit them directly into the reservoir and then back again once they start to return. This year more than 900 toads, plus frogs and newts were collected.

For many years Steve Rodgers has co-ordinated the patrols, supported by a group of volunteers. He has worked within the guidance of the nature group toad life to do this safely. In 2020 and 2021, no official patrols could be organised due to covid restrictions in the Spring but individuals did take their allowed daily exercise in the evenings and did collect the toads who were certainly not following any covid stay at home, social distancing or limited gathering restrictions! (Good job the Met. Police didn't find out about these partying amphibians!)

Steve and Lyn have now moved to Isla and so we need more people to join our list of patrollers for 2023. It's not an arduous task and can involve as few or as many evenings as you can manage.

We will send out another request for help next Jan/ Feb but if you are interested in helping please do let me know.
