Osmotherley Area Parish Council

Osmotherley Area Parish Council Meeting 20th April 2023

The council met on the third Thursday of the month as usual and five members of the public attended to raise concerns over the difficulties experienced with the footpath in front of the QC. The council have already reported its concerns with the National Park. The footpath isn't a straight clear line in front of the building and enquiries are underway as to the exact line this should take. The council wrote to the owner in September 2021 confirming our rights regarding the footpath and parking spaces.

The Summer Games - some residents have concerns that music and fireworks will cause disturbances in the village. It was agreed to ensure that the relevant authorities be notified.

Other matters - the leak on Clack Bank continues to stream and Highways have had a look at the problem which will need the tree/hedge roots cleared in the verge; this requires a high pressure jetter with a root cutter to undertake the work. Unfortunately, this is not something that will happen quickly but at least a fault has been identified! It is hoped to engage Highways to cut back overgrown grass on the footpaths in front of the Village Hall to aid wheelchair and push-chair access. An issue replicated on Clack Lane too. A full tree condition survey of the village trees will be commissioned. The damaged cobbles in front of Moon House will be repaired.

The annual accounts were presented to the council for approval and audit. It was emphasised by the PC that if any business or resident in the village did not follow the appropriate NYMNP requirements it is incumbent upon them to report any and all issues.

The next meeting and AGM is on the 18th May 2023.


