Osmotherley Area Parish Council

Osmotherley Area Parish Council Meeting and AGM 18th May 2023.

The AGM, where the election of Chair and Vice Chair take place confirmed that Richard Horner and Carolyn Nozedar would continue in the roles until May 2024.

Two residents attended the meeting.

The Clerk raised some ongoing actions and these were discussed as follows:

The osmotherley.org.uk website needed some attention and a resident kindly offered to help correct these.

Concerns have been expressed by residents concerning cars parked on the village green near Robin Hill on North End. It was agreed to look into erecting a further sign stating 'Parking Prohibited on Village Green by Order of the Parish Council'.

It is hoped that the bins in front of Moon house will be removed by the owner following recent correspondence and discussion. The Chairman is to meet with the owner in the near future.

The path in front of the village hall has been widened by the Caretaker which will hopefully enable easier wheelchair access.

A Tree survey of all parish council owned trees will be carried out shortly by a local arborists.

Parking concerns along School Lane have been discussed with Highways and a site visit will take place soon.

Concerns have been expressed regarding the Summer Games Fireworks and Music and authorities have been contacted for advice.

Investigations into tarmac-ing the missing part of the footpath at Bog Hole are underway.

Unfortunately the expected additional grant funding needed to upgrade the toilets in the village has not been forthcoming and alternative options are being looked into.

The Cleveland Way footpath is becoming overgrown along from Back Lane and the Clerk confirmed that this work is scheduled by NYM for early June.

A working party has been setup to look into unregistered areas of land in the villages of our parish. This is likely to take sometime before it can report on its findings.

The next meeting is on the 15th June 2023.
