Osmotherley Area Parish Council Meeting 18th April 2024

The Clerk updated the meeting on the continuing numerous highways concerns however progress has been limited in resolving them to our satisfaction and he was asked to continue to keep the pressure on Highways and the relevant land owners in an effort to expedite a resolution.

Some trees in the village trees are in need of urgent pruning. Consultation with NYMNP has been taken and approval given to carry out the work which has now been done.

The funding for the public toilets has still some way to go before the PC can be happy it has sufficient resources to undertake the project in accordance with the required specifications and quotations. The PC would ask if any village business or resident would feel able to contribute funds towards this project, the PC would be very happy to hear from them.

Concerns were raised about picnic tables which have been placed in a car parking space in front of the Three Tuns. A resident came to advise the meeting, on behalf of the owner, that these are surplus to requirement of the Three Tuns and has kindly offered the tables to the PC. The Clerk was asked to liaise with the owner to confirm this and agree the appropriate action.

The owner of The Old Vicarage contacted the PC regarding the collapsed wall to the front of their property. Discussions are ongoing with insurers and authorities to establish a suitable solution.

Three planning applications were raised and discussed.

The Clerk presented the final accounts of 2023/24, which have been audited and were approved by council.

Finally Mr Richard Horner advised the meeting that he is resigning from the PC with immediate effect, due to upcoming commitments that will demand more time away from home in the foreseeable future, which means that he will be unable to uphold the level of dedication and service the he believes the role requires. Councillors understood his reasoning and expressed their gratitude to him for all his hard work and voluntary service to the PC for the last seven years since 2017, and for his management as Chairman of the PC for the last three years, which have been difficult and challenging times for the village.


