REMEMBRANCETIDE

At the end of October Remembrancetide commences. The annual Poppy Appeal starts on Friday 24th October and runs until 11th November. Poppy boxes and trays will be in all the usual village outlets. Again this year all will display a QR code which you can use to pay by phone.

Remembrance Sunday falls on Sunday 9th November. This will follow the normal pattern of the parade of veterans and serving personnel and Act of Remembrance at the War Memorial supported by the Osmotherley Silver Band. This will be followed by a church service in St Peter's. A road closure will be in place during the Act of Remembrance with diversions via School Lane and Back Lane. Notices regarding this will be displayed prominently round the village.

Armistice Day marking the actual day that World War1 ended falls on Tuesday 11th November and the National Two Minutes Silence will be observed at the War Memorial at 11am. More details will appear in the November issue of the "Messenger." *David Black*

Osmotherley Area Parish Council-18 Sep 2025

A representative of Quickline, the broadband provider for the governments Project Gigabit, attended to discuss progress in the instigation of the provision, particularly in the village of Thimbleby, who have been suffering poor internet speeds. Residents of Thimbleby attended to raise issues and concerns and it was confirmed that an improved provision would not be available until November 2026.

Village gullies have been cleared, a damaged step has been repaired, the damaged bollard on North End replaced and work done to improve the war memorial by residents in the village.

The council expressed concern that the fly tipping on the Drovers Road had not been removed, after almost one month. The Clerk was asked to chase this up with NYC waste collection.

Concerns were expressed over the police reporting in August of no issues and this would be queried, especially with so much anti-social activity at Sheepwash and Cod Beck this summer. The area has been blighted by wild camping, illegal fires and BBQ's and other concerns throughout the hot summer and even though an awareness campaign with posters put up to warn visitors of these issues, little improvement was noted.

NYM have agreed that the village trees can be trimmed to maintain the size, particularly at low level. Some concerns with the quality of the play area equipment have been raised by the recent inspection. These issues will be rectified in the next view months.

The PC has been asked by NYM to identify two village footpaths that are to be put on a priority list for maintenance. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Remembrance Sunday on the 9th November preparations are underway.


